## Emergency Response Plan - activities done between October 2023 and July 2024

- We trained around 1,156 frontliners on PFA
- We've been working on social media content dissemination
- We've done (with WHO and PHEOC) trainings for hospitals on how to respond in terms of MHPSS in case there has been any mass casualties
- 160 physicians have been trained and 1,725 nursing and other staff have been trained this way

# NMHP latest action points regarding the activation of the Emergency Response Preparedness Plan

- 4Ws offline version is needed in case of internet cut
- Communication materials related to the emergency on social media
- Psychotropic medication provided through the PHCCs
- SbS contingency plan activation
- National lifeline contingency plan activated

#### Dr. Rabih El Chammay from NMHP:

- Please make sure that you are using the National List of Medication to make sure that in case you are out of stock, we can provide you from the already existing medication.
- Reminder to use 1564. The national lifeline operated by Embrace for both emotional support and suicide prevention.

## 2. Need of an update from each partner on the contingency plan from your side if there is an escalation in the situation

- We will be posting on social media alternative numbers for people to call in case of Ojero downtime (Embrace)
- If service users are unable to access their PHCC, they can receive their medication from another PHCC (NMHP)
- We are ensuring the supply of psychotropic medications at our available clinics (IMC)
- If the online modalities are not feasible, we are providing the partners with the materials and the activities that they can use offline (War Child)
- For individual sessions, including psychotherapy and psychiatric/neurological consultations, we'll scale down on face-toface sessions and we'll expand and strengthen the remote modality (Restart Center)
- We can provide an online consultation to help us to evaluate the need and provide appropriate care (IOCC)
